Volleyball

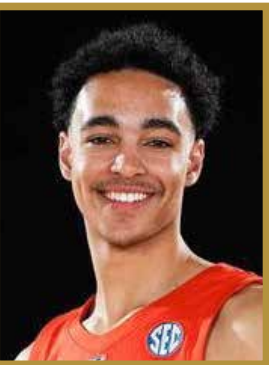
