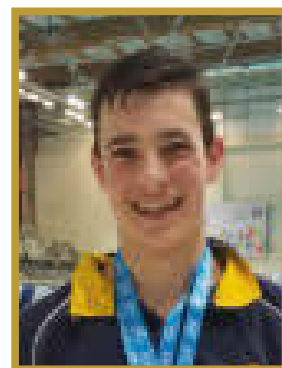


Lara Jorgensen
